Glynn County Police Criminal Investigators have arrested three individuals for committing thefts by entering automobiles on St. Simons Island.

Tommy Harper, age 17 of St. Simons Island, was arrested on June 24 at 5:30 pm at the Glynn County Police Department. He was charged with one count of entering auto in reference to a report made on June 22 on Brockington Drive on St. Simons. Twenty dollars in cash and a Glock firearm were reported stolen from an unlocked Ford truck. The firearm was recovered on June 23 at Harper's residence.

Christopher Hair, age 19 of St. Simons Island, was arrested on June 25 at 12:00 pm at the Glynn County Police Department. He was charged with one count of entering auto in reference to a report made on March 23, 2009 on Enclave Lane in the Sea Palms subdivision. Twenty five dollars in change was reported stolen from an unlocked Jeep.

Ryan Allen, age 17 of St. Simons Island, was arrested today at 12:10 pm at the Glynn County Police Department. Allen is charged with six counts of entering auto for the following offenses:

1. Unlocked 2007 Toyota was entered and a \$300 GPS was stolen. Reported on June 11 at 6:36 pm on Barkentine Court.
2. Unlocked 2006 Aucra was entered and a \$400 pair of prescription sunglasses were reported stolen on June 12 at 8:43 am on Brockington Marsh.
3. Unlocked 2004 Toyota was entered and a \$300 Ipod, \$40 purse hanger, \$34 of cigarettes and \$25 in cash were reported stolen on June 19 at 5:43 on Harrison Pointe Drive.
4. Unlocked 2005 Ford was entered and a \$450 Glock pistol and \$20 in cash were reported stolen on June 22 on Brockington Drive. (same charge as Tommy Harper.)
5. Unlocked 1997 Ford and an unlocked 2000 Lexus were entered; \$12 cash was taken from one vehicle and \$250 cash was taken from the other on June 22 on Ashwood Way.
6. Unlocked 1999 Mitsubishi was entered and a radar detector and set of keys were stolen on June 25 on Brockington Drive.
