## PRESS RELEASE January 15, 2010

Glynn County Police Criminal Investigators have arrested an individual who is responsible for numerous thefts and burglaries having occurred in Brunswick and Glynn County.

Joseph Stone Jr., age 28 of Nahunta, was arrested at GCPD on January 14 at 2:00 p.m. Stone has been charged with 5 counts of burglary; 3 counts of entering auto; two counts of misdemeanor theft by deception and 18 counts of financial transaction card fraud for the following crimes:

Entering auto reported on 1-4-10 at 7:39 a.m. at 1010 T. Street. Two credit cards were reported stolen. The cards were used numerous times at various locations.

Entering auto reported on 1-6-10 at 6:35 a.m. at 520 Ocean Blvd. on St. Simons Island. A 2006 Chevrolet pickup was entered and a \$300 crossbow was reported stolen. The crossbow has been recovered.
