Glynn County Criminal Investigators have made arrests on two recent business burglaries. On July 13th at 2:34 a.m. officers responded to Dollar General located at 5494 New Jesup Highway in reference to an alarm. Upon arrival, officers found the back door standing open. Forty dollars worth of various merchandise was stolen.

On July 15th at 12:41 a.m. officers responded to Snappy Foods located at 4200 Highway 99 in reference to suspicious activity. Officers discovered the front window of the store had been broken. Two hundred and sixty dollars worth of cigarettes were reported stolen.

Suspects were identified through video surveillance and the following suspects have been arrested:

Matthew Dillon Smith, age 18 of Brunswick has been charged with two counts of burglary.

In reference to the Dollar General burglary, two juveniles age 14 and 15 have been charged with burglary. Two 14 year old juveniles have been charged with the Snappy Foods burglary.
