On December 22 at 12:32 a.m. the Glynn County Police Department responded to a 911 call from 82 Glynn Marsh. The 35 year old resident Marcus Burton stated he heard a knock on the front door and saw a person with a gun. He dialed 911 at that time. The suspect then broke the rear sliding glass door of the home and entered the home demanding money. The home was occupied by Mr. Burton, his wife and five children ranging in age from four to eleven. The suspect was armed with a rifle and shot Mr. Burton striking him in the right arm and right side. The suspect fled on foot. The victim was transported to Southeast Georgia Regional Medical Center.

Based on the victim's statement and investigatory efforts, two people have been arrested. On December 22 at approximately 8 a.m. criminal investigators arrested Octavious Johnson, age 19 of Brunswick. Johnson was charged with armed robbery, burglary, aggravated assault, aggravated battery and possession of a firearm during the commission of a crime.

On December 23 at approximately 7 a.m. criminal investigators arrested James Bryson, age 19 of Brunswick. He was charged with burglary, aggravated assault, aggravated battery, possession of a firearm during the commission of a crime, criminal attempt to commit armed robbery and possession of cocaine.

On December 23, uniformed patrol officers located an AK-47 assault rifle approximately 250 feet from the incident location in a wooded area.

The investigation continues by Inv. Rod Nohilly.
